1.) When you're first eligible for Medicare

- Choose BCBSRI when you're first eligible for Medicare coverage (effective October 1, 2013, or later), AND
- Remain a BCBSRI Medicare Advantage member with no lapses in coverage since joining BCBSRI

You gain exclusive access to a one-time opportunity to change from a Medicare Advantage plan to an open Plan 65 Supplement plan in a future election period.

2. When you join BCBSRI from a non-BCBSRI Supplement plan

You can choose a BCBSRI **Medicare Advantage plan** and qualify for a one-time exception to elect an open BCBSRI **Plan65 Supplement plan** in the future during the election periods listed above.

To qualify for a change to an open BCBSRI Plan65 Supplement plan:

- You must remain a BCBSRI Medicare Advantage member for at least two years, AND
- Remain a BCBSRI Medicare Advantage member with no lapses in coverage since joining BCBSRI

What you need to do:

- 1. Become a BCBSRI Medicare Advantage member.
- 2. Call your current carrier to cancel your existing Medicare Supplement plan and request a termination letter that includes the coverage dates.
