

## 2023 Rhode Island Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Elderly (RIPAE) Fact Sheet





## Who Qualifies:

The Rhode Island Pharmaceutical Assistance to Elders (RIPAE) Program pays a portion of the cost of RIPAE-approved medications purchased during the Deductible stage of a Part D plan and will help if an individual's Part D plan does not cover a medication, provided it is an approved medication on the formulary. Annual income(s) determine which level of the program individuals are enrolled.

Qualifying Levels:				
Age 65 and older	Single Person	Married Couple	State Share	Member Share
Level 1	\$0 to \$35,867	\$0 to \$44,838	60%	40%
Level 2	\$35,867 to \$45,028	\$44,838 to \$56,304	30%	70%
Level 3	\$45,028 to \$78,947	\$56,304 to \$90,056	15%	85%
Level 4 (Ages 55 – 64)	\$0 to \$78,947	\$0 to \$90,056	15%	85%

<sup>\*</sup> Income guidelines were adjusted with a 5.9% increase effective 1/1/2023

## **Additional Qualifications:**

- You must be enrolled in a Medicare Part D plan
- · You can not be enrolled in Social Security Extra Help Program or Medicaid
- You must prove you are a Rhode Island resident

## **Additional Benefits:**

- For any RIPAE level, you will qualify for a one (1) time Special Enrollment Period (SEP) during a calendar year
- If you are eligible for Level 1, you will have free access to any Rhode Island state beach
