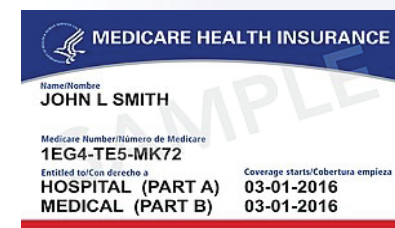

## Local Help Navigating Medicare

State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) Counselors provide, free, unbiased help with Medicare questions, plan selection, and enrollment support.

A certified Counselor will give you one-on-one guidance based on your unique situation and needs, including:

- ◆ Understanding your Medicare options
- ◆ Medicare plan comparisons and enrollment
- ◆ Medicare troubleshooting billing issues and appeals
- ◆ Screening for assistance for Medicare prescriptions and premiums
- ◆ Referral to other resources



## Protect Yourself & Medicare

The Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) program empowers and assists Medicare beneficiaries to prevent health care fraud, errors, and abuse.

**PREVENT Medicare fraud to protect yourself.**

Treat your Medicare and Social Security numbers like your credit cards. Never give these numbers to anyone you do not know.

**DETECT possible fraud, errors, and abuse**

Review your Medicare statements for mistakes by comparing them to your personal records.

**REPORT suspected fraud, errors, and abuse**

If you think you have been a target of fraud, report it.

You can learn to prevent, detect, and report Medicare fraud, errors, and abuse by contacting Rhode Island SMP.



## Save Money on Medicare Costs

If you have Medicare and need help paying your bills, there are programs that may be able to help you.

- ◆ **Extra Help Program** helps you pay for your prescriptions drug costs and coverage.
- ◆ **Medicare Savings Program** helps pay some Medicare costs for health care, including Medicare Part B premiums.

We also educate beneficiaries on:

- ◆ **Medicare Preventive Services** that are available to all Medicare beneficiaries and cover many preventive health services such as immunizations, screenings, and annual "Wellness" visits.
